Please do not repeat requests for the same tutorial topic in more than one term (in other words, you should provide a total of 6 different primary tutorial topics and 6 different secondary tutorial topics. If the tutorial must cover certain specific topics (e.g. to match a course at your home institution, so that you may obtain credit) please provide full details. If necessary continue onto a further sheet.

A wide variety of courses is available at Oxford. More information about them can be found on Mansfield's and the university's websites (www.mansfield.ox.ac.uk/prospective/studying/visiting-student-programme/subjects.html; www.ox.ac.uk: follow the link to 'Divisions and Departments') or in the publication *University of Oxford Examination Regulations*, which your Study Abroad Office may own. **Although provision of tuition in a particular subject cannot be guaranteed**, every effort will be made to match your tutorial requests. Economics teaching is organised centrally through the Economics Department and so restrictions apply to the courses available. The following options are currently available and should be taken as primary tutorials: British Economic History Since 1870; Command and Transitional Economies; Economic Decisions within the Firm; Economics of Developing Countries; Economics of Industry; Economics of OECD Countries; International Economics; Labour Economics; Money and Banking; Public Economics.
