



## Mansfield College Library Equality & Diversity collection contents

After the murder of George Floyd, students at Mansfield approached the Principal to build a list of books the Library could purchase to aid education on racism and racial issues, and the College responded enthusiastically. As a result, the Principal, Fellow Librarian and College Librarians launched a project to review the College's current collection and expand the Library's existing range of resources. Librarians, Clare Kavanagh and Sally Jones, reached out to students, staff, the Governing Body, and consulted Mansfield's community on Twitter, and together collated this list of more than 120 books crossing a wide range of disciplines. The collection now includes books relating to: [race](#), [gender](#), [sexuality](#), [refugee](#) and [disability](#) issues, as well as [feminism](#) and [psychology](#).








Materials are distributed throughout the Library in their appropriate subject areas; bookplates have been inserted in all books which are part of the Equality & Diversity collection; and there is a rotating display.








